Abstract

Collegiate Education Constituent Colleges Implementation of Computer Literacy Programme from the year 2005-2006 - Orders issued.

G.O.Ms.No.198

Dated: 21.6.2005

Read:

1. G.O.Ms.No.138, Higher Education dated 12.5.2000.
2. G.O.Ms.No.61, Higher Education dated 19.3.2003.
3. From that Director of Collegiate Education Letter No.5546/J3/2003. dated 7.12.2004, 18.1.2005 and 15.4.2005.

ORDER:

In the G.O first read above, the Government ordered to implement the Computer Literacy Programme for a period of five years from 2000-2001 in all erstwhile Government Arts and Science Colleges. Through ELCOT, three contractors implemented the scheme. As per the contract, all the infrastructure will become the property of the colleges. The Director of Collegiate Education has stated that the evaluation and Applied Research Department has observed that the Computer Literacy Programme has benefited socially and economically backward section of students hailing from poor families belonging to SC, ST, MBC and BC. The Director of Collegiate Education has reported that Computer Literacy Programme is taught in schools free of cost, that almost all students leaving Higher Secondary Schools and joining Under Graduate Courses have already been exposed to the use of Computers and that, therefore, the students, in the colleges may not show enthusiasm to join the programme by paying a fee. The Director of Collegiate Education has suggested that the Computer Literacy Programme may be continued from 2005-2006 as an optional one, on a self-sustaining basis without any additional financial commitment to Government.

2. The Government examined the recommendations of the Director of Collegiate Education and direct that the Computer Literacy Programme may be continued in the constituent colleges as an optional one on the following conditions:

- 1) The Principal of the colleges should admit only the willing students in Computer Literacy Programme on a one time fee of Rs.700/- at the time of admission.
- 2) The Principal may engage two Guest Lecturers for 100 students and honorarium of Rs.4,000/- per month for a period of six months i.e. from September to November and January to March. There should not be any restriction on the number of students. The Guest Lecturers can be engaged correspondingly as per Government norms.
- 3) Subject to Local Fund Audit, Fee collections shall be kept in P.D A/C II and expenditure towards payment to Guest Lecturers, Stationery etc shall be met from the above Fund. There should not be any financial commitment to the Government.

3. The Director of Collegiate Education is also directed to constitute a small working group to work out the guidelines for managing the existing infrastructure, the type of courses the facilities credited etc.

4. This orders issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its J.O.1643/F S/P/05 dated 23.5.2005.
