M.V.Muthiah Govt. Arts College for Women, Dindigul is a prestigious institution, a boon for rural girl students and for the first generation learner. The institute plays a pivotal role for the emancipation of rural students in their socio-economic status. Education provided here is thought provoking process which takes the students to explore, enrich, enlighten, empower.

The project A Study of Energising, Enhancing and Enriching UG and PG Final Year Students for Civil Services Examination for Employability opened avenues to face the challenges in the highly competitive current placement scenario.

The project aimed to:

- provide wide job opportunities available in the Central and State Govt. sectors
- make use of it for Employability
- help select students from socio-economically backward class
- give orientation at free of cost
- lift and sustain the standard of living of the rural girl students

The objectives were to:

- -create awareness on job opportunities available in State and Central Govt. sectors
- -appear and clear TNPSC and UPSC Examinations

- -communicate freely without any inhibitions
- -create opportunity for Self-Employability
- -strengthen English Communication/Aptitude Skills
- -promote thirst for knowledge
- -develop self-confidence
- -face challenges

Methodology: Individualized Program Plan was the Methodology followed in order to focus and stabilize the quality of the student. By studying the calibre, potential and mental courage of the student, proper attention and due importance was given to them to encourage and rejuvenate. The students were selected based on the performance scored in the Entry Level Test.

The study has applied SPSS (Statistical Package for the Social Sciences).

(Note: Due to pandemic and hence lock down was implemented, the classes were organized through Online Mode and later some classes and programme were conducted through offline mode)

Year-Wise plan of work and targets achieved: The study planned to have two sets per year comprised of 45 students in each set. Executed 91 students after having been given successful training program for Civil Services Examination which has assured the Employability.

I Batch - April, May, June, July

II Batch -Oct, Nov, Dec, Jan

The Project was inaugurated by Hon'ble S.D.Sundaresan IAS, the then Secretary to Govt. (Information and Publicity), Fire Service, Sainik Welfare and Freedom Fighter Cell, Special Secretary to Govt.(Home), Govt. of Puducherry and delivered lecture on 'An Effective Learning for Competitive Exams' (1st Session) and Energising, Enhancing and Enriching UG and PG Final Year Students for Civil Services Examinations and Employability-A Participatory Learning (2nd Session) on 15.3.2021. Select students from final year UG and PG were the participants.

His first lecture was brain storming on how to prepare for Competitive Exams which paved the way for many students to reach the next level of the preparation.

The second lecture was still more vibrant, lively and participatory with an enthusiastic ambience. Students were given freedom to ask questions and clarify doubts.

Regular Periodical Classes twice a week commenced since 1st week of April 2021 and ended in May 2022. The following were the Resource Persons who lectured on topics like General Knowledge, History, Current Affairs, Existing Vacancies in Central and State Govt. Posts, Duties and Eligibilty.
