
The college is committed to carving out generation who would take an active role in social activities. With this aim in view, extension services are made available to near by schools, villages and communities.


Demonstration on the preparation of washing gel and soap oil


Visiting Old Age Home (21.02.2023)

Synchronized Bird Census 2023 – Report



A one day “Synchronized Bird Census Programme (Phase 2: Terrestrial Birds) was conducted by the Tamil Nadu forest Department, Dindigul Division on 5 March 2023.

Our departmental students actively took part in the programme and learnt to identify different terrestrial birds located in Dindigul forest areas with the help of Ornithologists and forest department officials. Birds such as Greater Coucal – *Centropus sinensis*, Red-naped Ibis – *Pseudibis papillosa* and Inidan pond heron – *Ardeola grayii* were recorded among the other species spotted in this Census.

11 students from our III year B. Sc and 2 students from II year M. Sc participated along with 2 staff members (Ms. S. Maheshwari and Ms. S. Thamarai Selvi) in this programme.

Congratulations to all the Participating Institutions (PIs) selected under Unnat Bharat Abhiyan, a flagship program of Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD) Government of India through a challenge mode application. The Mission of Unnat Bharat Abhiyan is to enable participating higher educational institutions to work with the people of rural India in identifying development challenges and evolving appropriate solutions for accelerating sustainable growth. It also aims to create a virtuous cycle between society and an inclusive academic system by providing knowledge and practices for emerging professions and to upgrade the capabilities of both the public and the private sectors in responding to the development needs of rural India.


REPORT - 2022-2023
