

Chief Guest: Mr. G. Prabaharan, HR Deployment Team, PwC Acceleration Center, Bangalore




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VETERINARY INTERNSHIP TRAINING PROGRAMME

Veterinary Training Programme, May 2022

Three days (09.05.2022, 11.05.2022 and 12.05.2022) training programme was organized for the III rd year B. Sc students in the Tamil Nadu Veterinary Training and Extension Centre, Dindigul. 23 students and 3 staff took part in the programme.

First day (09.05.2022), Dr. Das Prakash, Assistant Professor & Head, 'Tamil Nadu Veterinary and Animal Sciences University' explained about the scope and various opportunities available for the students in rearing of animal husbandry. He elaborated about the space and other infrastructure required for establishing a dairy farm. He also explained about the maintenance of the dairy farm in hygienic condition. Moreover, he briefed about the epidemiology and treatment for most commonly occurring fungal (Mycoses) and viral diseases (Foot and mouth disease etc.) infecting the animals.
