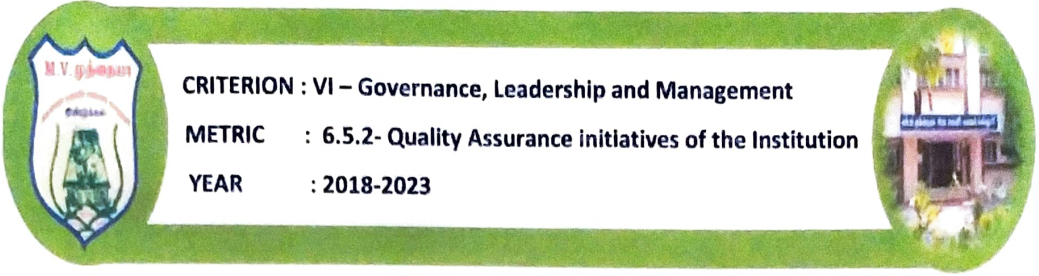



This **Memorandum of Understanding** (MOU) is entered into between the parties this May 16, 2022 which witnessed as hereunder.


