## 7.1.4 – 2 TOLERANCE AND HARMONY TOWARDS LINGUISTIC

Linguistics is the scientific study of language and it focuses on the systematic investigation of the properties and the characteristics of languages. It helps students understand regional dialects and colloquialism. Linguistic is the investigation of human language and it also deals with analysis and research of social aspects of literary world. Phonetics in the language study deals with form, meaning and context of languages and also includes the study of several factors such as social, political, historical and cultural factors that influence language.

Throughout the world, the linguistics is meant for how we communicate, how to generate spoken word, how to spell, how to develop and coin new words and the need for a vivid vocabulary. Nowadays the uses of mobiles, android phones, and internet and web sites have increased the power of usage of different languages and influence their interest to learn many languages.

In India, the specialized courses in the field of linguistics are offered by various colleges and universities. Students can pursue undergraduate, post graduate, diploma and certificate courses of linguistic at different levels.

Our college offers two linguistic courses such as Tamil and English. The course for language study was started in 1966. Since then, there has been a demand for admission in both the courses. Tamil is the oldest Language and a prime source for studying the

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contributions of Dravidian languages and cultures; the literary and cultural mosaic of the regions and religions. The department of Tamil offers Tamil as the first language to various branches of UG students. 3 years UG programme, 2 years PG programme and M.Phil in Tamil are offered in the department. Every year the department conducts Muthamizhvizha, Seminars, Workshops and other innovative programmes to inculcate the interest in students to learn Tamil language and enlighten its power of pride and importance.

English department is a research department. English is offered as the second language for all major students. 3 years UG programme, 2 years PG programme, M.Phil and PhD in English are offered in the department. As it is a research department, many scholars pursue their research programme under able guidance of the faculty members of English Department. Many faculties are also pursuing their research under the guidance of the staff of the same department.

Students are interested to learn English as it is the language for international communication. It helps students to progress personally and professionally. It improves their career skills and thus, they can compete in the global job market. It is the language of arts, sciences, computers, tourism, etc. Studying English helps them to search for job and plan to travel the world anywhere. The department of English conducts Literary Association meetings, seminars, conferences and the programmes to improve the communicative skills and confidence level of the students in every walk of their life.

In order to motivate the students to learn English language, the subjects incorporated in the syllabi include General Application skills in English usage, Presentation skills; Creative writing, English for Corporate employment, English for Employability and Writing for the media. These influence the language skills of the students.

The department of English engages the government school students with immense interest and imbibes them to learn about vocabulary enrichment, sentence pattern, framing sentences and word games etc.
